C.F. woman wanted for non-support charged with narcotics distribution within a school zone:

CENTRAL FALLS – On February 10, 2016 members of the Central Falls Police Special Investigative Unit (SIU) executed a court authorized search warrant upon the second floor rear apartment of 433 Hunt Street.

Upon entry, detectives came in contact with a female identified as Luz Morales, 40, who is the renter of the apartment as well as the target of the investigation. She was subsequently detained while a comprehensive search of the residence was conducted whereby detectives located and seized a sizeable quantity of crack cocaine within Morales' bedroom.

She was later transported to police headquarters for processing and held overnight. Morales was arraigned this morning on charges of manufacture and delivery of cocaine, and distribution of narcotics near a school zone. In addition, she had two Family Court warrants for non-support and one Superior Court bench warrant.

Although Morales was allowed bail in the amount \$30,000 with surety on the new offenses she was held on the Superior Court warrant. Her next scheduled court appearance is April 12, 2016.
