Investigation surrounding missing Central Falls teen reached successful conclusion:

Central Falls – On March 1, 2015, Charles Engley, the sixteen year old reported missing to Central Falls Police was located by authorizes.

Missing since Tuesday morning, Charles was discovered to have traveled to New York City sometime Wednesday morning until his return home by train last evening. He purportedly sold his cellphone for travel expenses, finding refuge in homeless shelters. His whereabouts were confirmed when Charles had reached out to his mother on his tablet via Facebook mid-afternoon.

Although he looked in good health, Charles was brought to Hasbro Children’s Hospital purely as a precautionary measure; he was later released to the custody of his father.

The untiring investigation was conducted by members of the Central Falls Police Detective Bureau, along with the Rhode Island State Police Computer Crimes Unit and the Providence Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

“I’d like to thank Colonel Mendonca and the Central Falls Police Department, and state and federal law enforcement agencies for helping to find Charles” said Mayor Diossa. “Additionally, I’d like to thank the Central Falls community and the media for their help and support

during the search. This was truly a community effort and I'm grateful to know that Charles is in safe hands once again"
