Navigant Credit Union Bank Robbery Suspect Apprehended:

CENTRAL FALLS – On March 9, 2016 at approximately 1:20pm the Central Falls Police Department was notified that a male suspect had just attempted to rob the Navigant Credit Union located at 693 Broad Street.

According to credit union staff the suspect had entered the bank and handed one of the tellers a note demanding money. After not receiving the cash stipulated, he fled the institution on foot. Responding officers were subsequently furnished an image of the perpetrator which was shared with neighboring Pawtucket Police.

The suspect, later identified as Moses Dalmeida (34), of Pawtucket was located a short time later hiding between vehicles in the area of Cross and Roosevelt Avenue. With the assistance of Pawtucket Detective Sue Cormier he was placed into custody without incident.

Dalmeida was transported to the Central Falls police station for processing where he held until his arraignment this morning in the 6th District Court on the charge of second degree robbery and possession of crack cocaine. The narcotics were found on his person at the time of his arrest. In addition, Pawtucket Police had a warrant for his arrest.

Although Dalmeida was given bail in the amount of \$10,000 with surety on the new charge he was ordered held as a Superior Court Violator. No court date has been set to answer the new charges.

The police chief, Colonel James J. Mendonca, credits quick response and exceptional cooperation among neighboring jurisdictions, and credit union staff, with timely arrest of bank robber. “Another bad guy off the street thanks to all involved”.
