### **Suspect Sought in Connection with Beacon Street Shooting:**

CENTRAL FALLS – On May 7, 2016 an arrest warrant was signed for Moses Vieira Cabral (22) with a last known address of 15 Beacon Street, 2nd floor. The arrest warrant was obtained by the detective bureau for Cabral after a search warrant was executed at his residence by Central Falls detectives, along with a K-9 unit and the state police tactical team – stemming from a shooting investigation.

The crime happened around 1:45 a.m. on Beacon Street where 23-year-old Felix Cepeda, of Central Falls, was shot inside a car and was transported to Rhode Island Hospital – he is currently listed in stable condition.

As a result of the search, a large amount of crack cocaine and marijuana was discovered in Cabral's apartment, along with other articles of evidentiary value. The arrest warrant for Cabral includes the following charges: possession with intent to distribute cocaine; distribution of a controlled substance near a school; and possession of marijuana.

Although the aforementioned charges are unrelated to the shooting investigation, Cabral is a person of interest in that that crime – along with others.

Cabral is described as a black male, last known to be approximately 5'9" and 170 lbs. He has tattoos to his right arm, right hand, right wrist and left wrist. He has resided in several areas within Rhode Island over the past two years; however, he is originally from Dorchester, Massachusetts – with ties to Quincy.

Cabral should be considered armed and dangerous due to the firearms related offense his is currently tied to. Anyone with information as to the whereabouts of this individual is urged to contact the Central Falls Police at (401) 727-7411 or your local police department
