### **Juvenile Male and Adult Female Arrested after Foot Chase:**

CENTRAL FALLS – On July 14, 2015 at approximately 11:51am units responded to the area of High and Cross Street's for a report of a male running and screaming with a knife in his hands.

Upon officers arrival they were informed by dispatch that the male with the knife was hiding inside a black Honda parked on Jenks Street. Officers then proceeded up Jenks Street and located the black Honda and noticed two individuals hiding in the back seat. One of the individuals managed to flee the area on foot towards Broad Street, leading officers on a lengthy foot pursuit.

After a prolonged period of time, the assailant emerged back onto Broad Street and ran into the parking lot of Cumberland Farms where a Nissan Murano was observed parked with two occupants. A female seated in the passenger side shouted and gestured for the assailant to get in, and as he ran around to the operator's side back door, the driver of the vehicle indicated that he was not getting into her car and locked all the doors to the vehicle.

The foot chase then continued for a short time longer until the assailant was caught by Central Falls Detectives, with the assistance of Fire Lieutenant Matt Moulton. During a subsequent search incident to arrest, a small plastic bag containing three pieces of crack cocaine was located in his pant pocket.

The female passenger of the Nissan Murano, later identified as Naomi Ramsdell, 27, of Pawtucket was also placed under arrest and charged with Obstructing an Officer in the Execution of their Duty for her attempt

in aiding our assailant in eluding capture by police. She also had a 6th District Court Warrant. Ramsdell was processed and arraigned in 6th District Court yesterday afternoon and later released on \$1000.00 surety bail. She was given a future court date of July 28, 2015.

The male arrestee, later determined to be a 15 year-old juvenile from Central Falls, was processed and later transported to the Rhode Island Training School where he was held overnight. He was arraigned this morning in Family Court on an outstanding Family Court Warrant for the following offenses: Second Degree Robbery; Felony Assault; Conspiracy; and Disorderly Conduct.

He was subsequently arraigned on new charges of Possession of Cocaine; Resisting Arrest; and Obstruction of a Police Officer in the Execution of their Duty. He was subsequently ordered held at the Rhode Island Training School until July 22, 2015 when he will be brought back to Family Court for a Probable Cause Hearing.
