Three suspects apprehended in connection with breaking and entering:

CENTRAL FALLS – Officers responded to 7 Washington Street, third floor, for reports of a breaking and entering in progress. Officers entered the apartment building and noted that the door to the third floor was forced open and that the apartment was in complete disarray.

Upon arrival, officers learned that a subject described as a dark skinned male had just left the house and met with three additional subjects in the driveway. A witness description of all four subjects was given out to officers who were actively searching the area.

Approximately ten minutes later three subjects matching the previous descriptions were stopped by officers. The subjects were later identified as Derek Davis (20); Andrew Lorh (18); and a juvenile male (16). The trio was subsequently positively identified as three of the four assailants who were present during the breaking and entering.

The Central Falls Detective Bureau later learned through suspect interviews that the juvenile male forced entry into the apartment as the two adult males, previously identified, stood as look outs. All three subjects were placed under arrest, processed and later transported to District Court and Family Court for their arraignments.

Derek Davis was arraigned and held as a violator in Superior Court and District Court, Andrew Lohr was given bail of \$5000.00 with surety. The juvenile male was presented in Family Court and arraigned.
