CF juveniles arrested for robbery, cyber-harassment, and five other offenses:

Central Falls – On September 28, 2015 Central Falls police detectives obtained and executed arrest warrants for three female juveniles, all sisters, ages 14, 15 and 17, stemming from an incident which occurred in front of their apartment building four nights prior.

At 10:00 PM on September 24, 2015, a Central Falls police detective was flagged down on Broad Street by two 15 year old females who were beaten with discernable injuries. They alleged they were assaulted and robbed of a cell phone by three sisters who reside on Fletcher Street in Central Falls.

The investigation turned to Facebook where the suspects recorded and posted videos, and photos to their respective accounts accompanied by insults toward the victims. Additionally, the mother of the assailants commented in text under one of the videos posted on social media slurring one of the teen victims.

The trio was arrested at their home without incident on Monday and arraigned this morning at Family Court in Providence on the charges of 2nd degree robbery, conspiracy to commit robbery, two counts of cyberharassment, two counts of simple assault, and disorderly conduct.

The 17 and 15 year old defendants were ordered held at the Rhode Island Training School until a future court hearing and the 14 year old accused was released on home confinement with electronic monitoring.
