Central Falls Police arrest duo on multiple car break-ins:

CENTRAL FALLS – On December 30, 2015 at approximately 1:30am officers were dispatched to Chiqui Muffler Shop, located at 601 Lonsdale Avenue, regarding a call received from a neighbor stating that there were two males inside the fenced-in parking lot rummaging through various cars.

The entire lot is known to be surrounded by a large chain-link fence and the responding officers noticed that the gate was secure and intact; as such, the only discernable way to enter the business after hours was to scale the enclosure. Officers surrounded the area and soon discovered that there were two individuals attempting to hide within the lot. The suspects eventually complied with orders to stay put and put their hands above their head as officers scaled the fence to apprehend them.

A subsequent search and investigation of the business yard revealed that nine vehicles had been tampered with by the pair who have been identified as Acheal Harris (19) and Valdez Loiseau (20); both having no permanent address. They were held overnight until their arraignment this morning in District Court where they were charged with conspiracy; nine counts of injuring and tampering with vehicles; four counts of larceny; possession of burglary tools; and trespassing. Harris and Loiseau were ordered held on \$5000 bond with surety with a next scheduled court date of March 2, 2016.
