### **Subject Arrested for Narcotics Possession and Distribution within a School Zone:**

CENTRAL FALLS – On September 22, 2015 the Central Falls police departments Special Investigations Unit (SIU) in conjunction with members of the Detective Bureau executed a search warrant at 22 Rand Street, first floor.

The renter and focus of the investigation Kai Jackson (37) was located within the targeted apartment and detained. A systematic search of the residence resulted in the discovery of a sizeable measure of heroin, cocaine and “molly (MDMA) which was seized as evidence. In addition, \$1684.00 in U.S. currency was confiscated for forfeiture.

Jackson was subsequently taken into custody and transported to Central Falls police headquarters for processing and held overnight until his arraignment this morning in 6<sup>th</sup> District Court on the following charges: possession of heroin with intent to deliver, possession of cocaine with intent to deliver, possession of schedule I and II narcotics with intent to deliver and distribution of narcotics within a school zone.

Jackson was ordered held without bail at the ACI on the aforementioned offenses and will be presented in Superior Court as violator on a date not yet determined.
