Two Suspects Captured in Home Invasion:

CENTRAL FALLS – On April 19, 2015 at approximately 11:14pm officers responded to the area of 89 Butler Avenue for a report of a disturbance.

As officers were responding, dispatch relayed that a second 911 caller reported that the three male assailants were fleeing the area west on Butler Avenue.

As officers approached the area, the three subjects who matched the 911 caller's description seemingly observed the approaching police vehicles and began to run towards Dexter Street; two of the subjects were apprehended after a short foot pursuit.

One was identified as Mayovanex Oleaga (23) of Central Falls and the second was a 17 year old male residing from Pawtucket.

Upon stopping the subjects, a cell phone and wallet – later found to belong to one of the victims – were located. The two were then held pending further investigation.

Shortly thereafter the victim's identity was established and a formal complaint taken. They asserted that their assailants knocked on their apartment door, and as it was opened, the trio began to strike the victims in the face and head area with closed fists, beer bottles and feet and then fled the area with their personal effects.

The victims, whom sustained face, body and blunt force trauma injuries to their heads, were transported to Pawtucket Memorial Hospital for treatment.

The two suspects were placed under arrest and transported to the station for processing.

Mayovanex Oleaga was arraigned on yesterday in 6th District Court Providence, charged with:

2- Counts of First Degree Robbery

1-Count of Burglary

1-Count of Conspiracy

1-Count of Resisting Arrest

Oleaga was ordered held until a May 4, 2015 Bail Hearing.

The juvenile male was arraigned yesterday also in Family Court Providence, charged with:

2-Counts of First Degree Robbery

1-Count of Burglary

1-Count of Conspiracy

The juvenile was ordered held until April 28, 2015 for a Probable Cause Hearing on April 28, 2015.

The third assailant has yet to be identified; as such, this case is still under investigation.
