Central Falls Police Arrest Subject for Discharging Firearm:

CENTRAL FALLS – Last evening at approximately 9:04 p.m., officers responded to 82 Cowden Street for a report of a man discharging a firearm behind the dwelling.

Upon arrival, officers were able to identify the male from a clothing description given by the caller and relayed to them by police dispatch. The officers acted quickly and courageously to secure the area and verbally de-escalate the volatile situation.

The suspect, Cesar Ramirez (52) who appeared to be intoxicated, was taken into custody without further incident or harm to anyone.

A .380 caliber handgun was recovered with two magazines and several rounds of ammunition. After completing a security sweep of the area, officers located and seized eight spent shell casings in the yard adjacent to the residence.

Ramirez was arraigned in 6th District Court this morning on charges of Firing in a Compact Area and Carrying a Weapon While Intoxicated. He was released on \$10,000 personal recognizance.
