Central Falls Police make arrest in “chop shop” and seize narcotics and firearms in the process:

CENTRAL FALLS – On July 24, 2013 members of the Central Falls Patrol Bureau responded to the area of Cross Street and Pine Street for a disturbance. While at that location the officers discovered what appeared to be a stolen motorcycle ring.

The Detective Bureau was called in to further investigate the scene; as a result, Jason Goncalves (31) of 423 Pine Street was arrested and charged with nine separate felony offenses.

The suspect was arraigned in Sixth District Court this morning on two felony counts of Receiving Stolen Goods; three counts of Manufacturing and Delivery of Narcotics; three counts of Possession of a Firearm while Violating the Controlled Substance Act; and one count of Possession of a Firearm with an Altered Identification Number.

Goncalves is being held without bail at the A.C.I. until his next court appearance scheduled August 7th. The Investigation remains open whereas additional arrests and or further charges could result.
