Central Falls Police Seek Suspect in Early Morning Stabbing:

CENTRAL FALLS – Central Falls Police responded to 3 Illinois Street early this morning for a report of a stabbing. Upon arrival, they located a victim with several stab wounds to the abdominal area and extremities. Rescue immediately responded and transported the victim to Rhode Island Hospital where is currently undergoing surgery.

The suspect in this case is identified as Eduardo Calderon (59) who had fled the area prior to police arrival; however, a witness to the assault stated that the two men had been arguing all day and had walked in on this most recent altercation. The witness observed that the victim was bleeding and confronted Calderon whereby he immediate fled the apartment. The witness subsequently called 911 and stood by for police and rescue personnel.

The victim's name is being withheld until family can be first notified.

Central Falls Police Detectives have obtained an arrest warrant for Eduardo Calderon; therefore, anyone with knowledge of his whereabouts is urged to contact the Central Falls Police Department. He is currently homeless and is known to visit shelters throughout the state. The lead investigator in this case is Detective Craig M. Viens.
